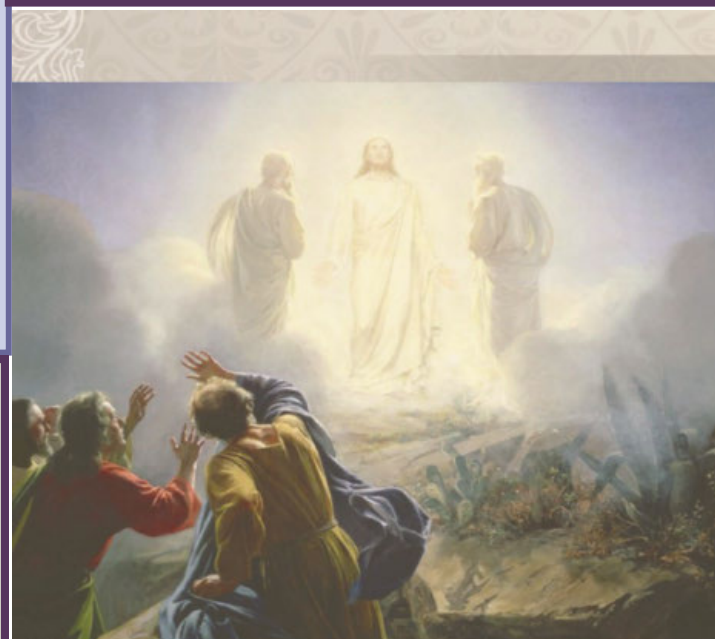

## Profession of Faith

The profession of faith is a sign by which the baptized recognize their own identity; it expresses the central content of their faith and summarizes the main truths that a believer accepts and testifies to on the day of their baptism. There are various professions of faith, which shows the richness of the experience of encountering Jesus Christ. Traditionally, however, there are two that have gained special recognition in the Church: the baptismal creed of the church of Rome and the Nicene Constantinopolitan creed, originally formulated in 325 at the Council of Nicaea, in present-day Turkey, and then refined at the Council of Constantinople in 381. "If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

For one believes with the heart and so is justified, and one confesses with the mouth and so is saved" (Rom. 10:9-10). This passage from St. Paul emphasizes how proclaiming the mystery of faith requires a deep conversion not only in one's words, but especially of one's understanding of God, oneself and the world.

## Profesión De Fe

La profesión de fe, también llamada "símbolo", es un signo de reconocimiento propio de los bautizados; en ella se expresa el contenido central de la fe y se recogen sintéticamente las principales verdades que un creyente acepta y de las que da testimonio en el día de su bautismo y comparte con toda la comunidad cristiana para el resto de su vida. Existen varias profesiones de fe, que muestran la riqueza de la experiencia del encuentro con Jesucristo. Sin embargo, tradicionalmente, las que han adquirido un especial reconocimiento son dos: el credo bautismal de la iglesia de Roma y el credo nicenoconstantinopolitano, elaborado originalmente en el año 325 por el Concilio de Nicea, en la actual Turquía, y perfeccionado después en el de Constantinopla en el año 381. "Porque, si profesas con tus labios que Jesús es Señor, y crees con tu corazón que Dios lo resucitó de entre los muertos, serás salvo. Pues con el corazón se cree para alcanzar la justicia, y con los labios se profesa para alcanzar la salvación" (Rm 10,9-10). Este texto de san Pablo subraya cómo la proclamación del misterio de la fe exige una conversión profunda no solo de las propias palabras, sino también y sobre todo de la propia visión de Dios, de uno mismo y del mundo. «Recitar con fe el Credo es entrar en comunión con Dios Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, es entrar también en comunión con toda la Iglesia que nos transmite la fe y en el seno de la cual creemos» (CCC 197).
