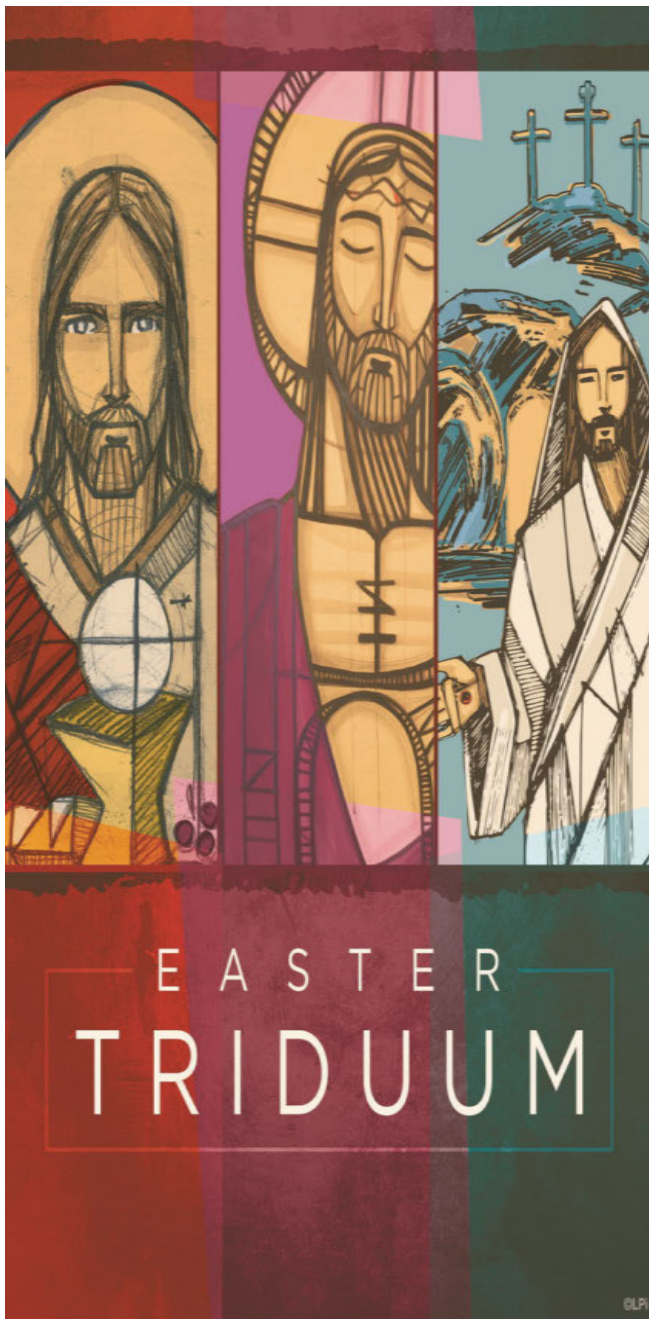

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This week we start Holy Week. We do so traditionally by acknowledging this Sunday as Palm Sunday and we sing Hosanna and wave our palms at the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. Yet it is also acknowledged as Passion Sunday, as this day maintains the inherent tension that exists between the joyful entry of the palm processional and the somberness of the passion, the focus of Holy Week.

If we leap from Palm Sunday's "Hosanna" to Easter Day's "Alleluia" we overlook the pivotal event of Christ's suffering and death on the cross. The journey to Jerusalem has the cross as its goal, and the cross needs to be kept in sight even during the triumphant entry into Jerusalem. All of Holy Week then points toward the passion—the death and resurrection of Christ. The week's three final days (from sunset Thursday through sunset on Easter) complete the commemoration of Christ's passion. These three days are called the Triduum. The way to the triumph of Easter is through the Triduum.

Maundy Thursday (or *le mandé*; Thursday of the Mandatum, Latin, commandment). The penitential acts of Maundy Thursday have celebratory aspects of restoration through the bold declaration of pardon; the act of foot washing connoting humility and intimacy; the celebration of the Lord's Supper embodying the mystery of Christ's enduring redemptive presence.

The Good Friday service is a penitential service and is a day in which to allow for numerous contemplative moments, and to permit the power of silence to speak for itself.

On the final night of the Triduum take a moment and pause in vigil, remembering stories about who we have been and are now becoming. The Easter Vigil is akin to sitting around a campfire while listening to the stories of generations past and future.

Who we are is a very long story of how we were made, of how God chose us from among all peoples, of how God liberated us from bondage, of how God planted us in the promised land, of how, in these last times, God has given the story a new twist in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus all in anticipation of Easter.....

I invite you and your family to come, join in on these last days of the journey this Lent, as we gather as a community on Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and of course Easter Sunday. It will be a blessing for our faith community to have you walk with us during the Triduum this year.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Esta semana comenzamos la Semana Santa. Lo hacemos tradicionalmente al reconocer éste domingo como Domingo de Ramos y cantamos el Hosanna y agitamos nuestras palmas a la entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén. Sin embargo, también se le conoce como el Domingo de la Pasión, ya que en éste día se mantiene la tensión inherente que existe entre la entrada alegre de la procesión de las palmas y la tristeza de la pasión, enfoque de la Semana Santa.

Si nos saltamos del "Hosanna" del Domingo de Ramos al "Aleluya" del Domingo de Resurrección, nos perdemos del evento crucial del sufrimiento de Jesucristo y de su muerte en la cruz. El viaje a Jerusalén tiene como meta la cruz, y la cruz debe mantenerse a la vista incluso durante su entrada triunfal en Jerusalén. Toda la Semana Santa apunta hacia la pasión: la muerte y la resurrección de Cristo. Los tres últimos días de la semana (desde la puesta del sol del jueves hasta la puesta del sol en la Pascua) completan la conmemoración de la pasión de Cristo. A éstos tres días se llaman Triduo. El camino hacia el triunfo de la Pascua es a través del Triduo.

Jueves Santo (o *mandé*; Jueves del Mandatum, en latín, o mandamiento). Los actos penitenciales del Jueves Santo, tienen aspectos festivos de la restauración a través de la declaración audaz del perdón; el acto de lavarse los pies tienen una connotación de humildad e intimidad; la celebración de la Cena del Señor encarna el misterio de la presencia redentora perdurable de Cristo.

El servicio del Viernes Santo es un servicio penitencial y es un día en el que tenemos numerosos momentos contemplativos y permite que el poder del silencio hable por sí mismo.

En la última noche de éste viaje al Triduo, tómense un momento y hagan una pausa en vigilia, recordando historias sobre quiénes hemos sido y en qué nos estamos convirtiendo. La Vigilia Pascual es similar a sentarse alrededor de una fogata mientras escucha las historias de generaciones pasadas y futuras.

Quiénes somos es una historia muy larga de cómo fuimos creados, de cómo Dios nos escogió de entre todos los pueblos, de cómo Dios nos liberó de la esclavitud, de cómo Dios nos plantó en la tierra prometida, de cómo, en estos últimos tiempos, Dios le ha dado a la historia un nuevo giro a la vida, muerte y resurrección de Jesús todo esto en anticipación a la Pascua de Resurrección.....

Los invito a usted y a su familia a que participen en estos últimos días del viaje de ésta Cuaresma, a que nos reunamos como comunidad el Jueves Santo, el Viernes Santo y, por supuesto, el Domingo de la Pascua de Resurrección. Será una bendición para nuestra comunidad de fe que usted venga a caminar con nosotros durante el Triduo este año.

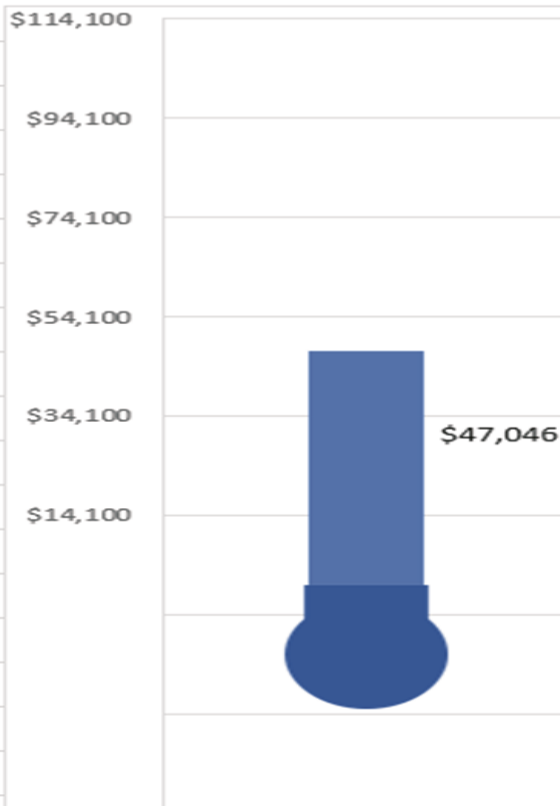

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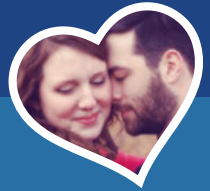
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
