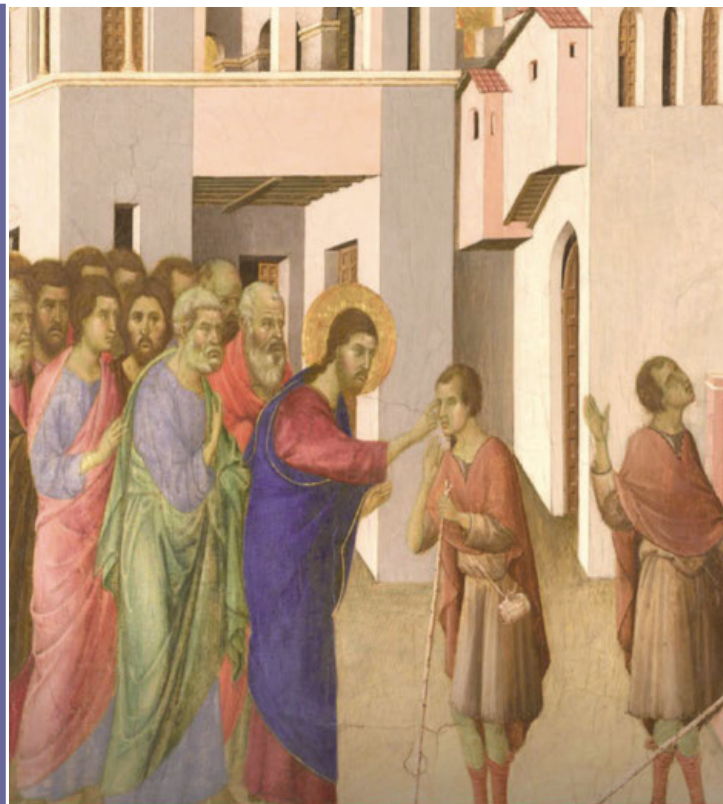

One of the most touching YouTube videos I've ever seen is one in which a deaf woman receives new technology to heal her hearing. She hears her husband's voice for the first time — and her own, too — and bursts into tears of overwhelming joy. It must have been like an immovable wall between her and her loved ones came tumbling down.

We are all like this woman, to some degree. We believe in the presence of God's love, but we can't hear Him. We can't speak well about Him. The deaf man who can't speak properly in the Gospel today is an image of what God wants us to experience again and again. Jesus takes the man aside to a private place away from the crowd, touches his ears and tongue, and says, "**Ephphata!**" The man's ears are opened, and he speaks clearly. Contact with Christ has this effect on us.

This experience happens to us in our baptism, almost exactly. It happens to us in the liturgy. It happens in our private prayer. It happens when we hear the voice of God in our conscience. The more we engage these privileged channels of Jesus' healing, the more we are empowered to hear and speak of the presence of God's perfect love.

Se imaginan que, en la familia, papá y mamá con sus hijos, lo hicieran todo bien. La Palabra de Dios nos dice hoy que la gente se expresaba de Jesús de la mejor manera y comentaban entre ellos lo siguiente: "*Todo lo ha hecho bien; hace oír a los sordos y hablar a los mudos*" (Marcos 7:37). Muchas veces, por evitar problemas, preferimos hacernos los desentendidos, fingiendo que no vemos y no podemos hablar. "No te metas en problemas, mejor no digas nada de lo que viste". Y así aceptamos la violencia familiar, los robos y las mentiras entre la familia y la sociedad.

Con esas actitudes, nunca llegaremos a un diálogo que permita conocer las situaciones que vive nuestro prójimo y comprender con la mente y el corazón lo que está pasando a nuestro alrededor, y lo más importante dejar que la persona sienta que nos importa. También nos puede pasar lo mismo cada domingo que asistimos a Misa, que, por estar distraídos en otros pensamientos y otras situaciones, evitamos escuchar la voz de Dios. Porque Dios nos habla de mil formas en nuestra vida. Un modo especial en el que Dios nos habla es por medio de la oración. ¿Lo escuchamos?

Thank you to all of our parents that attended our Parent Meetings last week. As we begin our formation year this week we again share with you some important safety reminders...

- Parents with children in grades K-8 must walk their children to their classrooms and sign them in and out. Please do not drop them off at the stairs and send them in on their own.
- K-8 participants will go directly to the Wagner building classrooms unless instructed otherwise by the formation staff.
- High school youth should enter and sign in at the Youth Center and will be picked up there as well.
- Please be mindful of safety in the parking lot and watch for children getting out of vehicles.
- Gates to the Wagner building will open 10 minutes before the session begins for drop off and will close promptly at 6pm. If you arrive late, you will drop off your child at the gate with the staff or volunteer who will then take your child to their session. Gate will be open 5 minutes prior to the sessions ending for pick up.

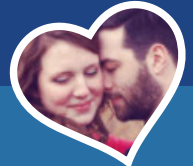
