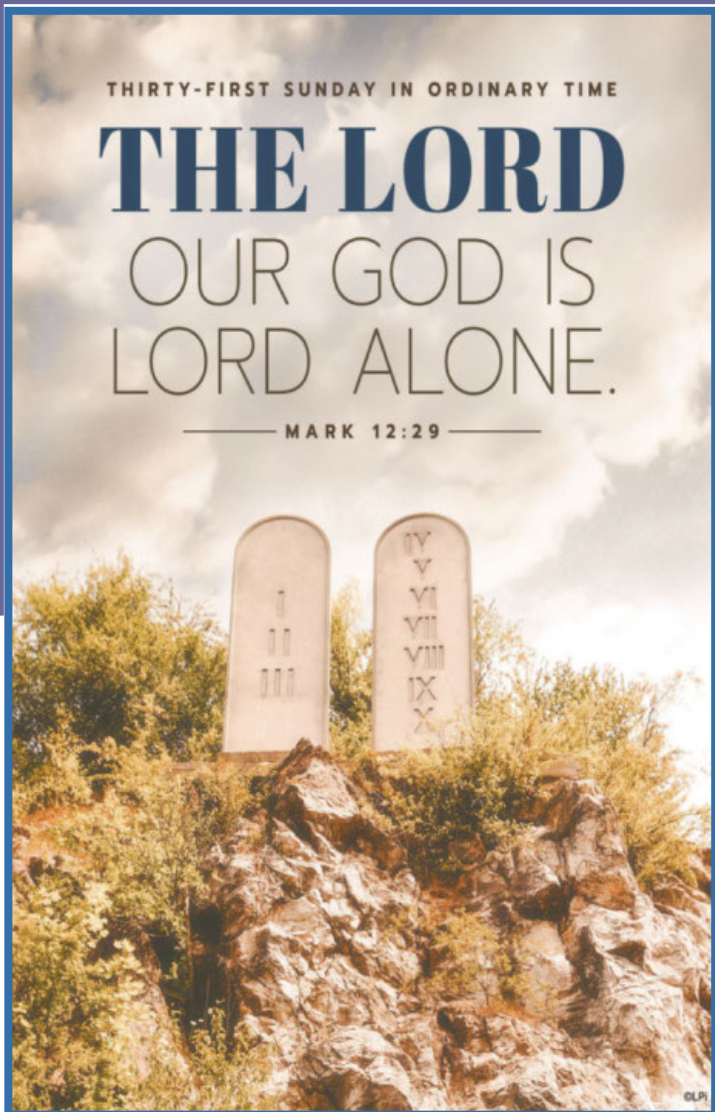

## READER TESTIMONY

I am Ernie Cruz, a parishioner of St. Catherine of Alexandria for 17 years. I have been a member of the Ministry of Readers since I became a parishioner. I have been a Reader for the past 27 years which included my residency in my previous parishes.

As a Reader I experienced how to be like a prophet who were sent by God to speak to His people about his good news to mankind. As I prepare to deliver the reading of the day, I learned to understand more of the meaning of God's messages which inspired me how to give life to the reading as I deliver it to the congregation. It reminds me also to be always in communion with God whenever I serve HIM as a Reader. I found great happiness and delight in serving God thru this ministry in a humble way.

In November 2021, I was diagnosed with terminal ailment and was informed by my doctor I had three (3) months to live if I did not undergo a very delicate and sensitive brain surgery. There was no guarantee of success and there was a possibility of side effects. Entrusting my life to the grace of God and intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mother, I agreed.

The surgery was successful, but the possible side effect that was mentioned to me rendered my left side of the body paralyzed and my speech distorted. I could not walk and speak clearly. It was a very depressing time for me then. I could not go to church and could no longer serve as a Reader.

However, there was a turning point in my life during my immobility when I started to receive from many parishioners e-mails, phone calls, prayer cards by mail and the Holy Rosary organized all for the intentions of a speedy recovery. The visits and counselling from our priests gave me so much moral support also. I was so overwhelmed for the love, caring and compassion that the entire community offered to me during my time of great need.

After more than a year of various rehabilitations, my wife Imelda, encouraged me to go back and serve again as a Reader in the church to which I hesitated. But thru her insistence, she practiced with me regularly. I read with her as my lone audience. The time came when I was very confident I could read again so I seeked the permission of the Pastor whether I can read again during the mass in my wheelchair. I was so happy when I received his approval. To date I am still a Reader in the weekend masses in my WHEELCHAIR.

I do not know anymore how to thank and count the so many blessings that God rewarded me. I express also my heartfelt gratitude to the entire parish community for their wonderful spiritual and moral support. It encouraged me to continue serving in the Ministry of Readers for as long as I can.

I am happy to invite our parishioners to join our ministry and I will be happy to assist also in training personally to those who will sign in as volunteers.

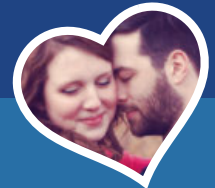

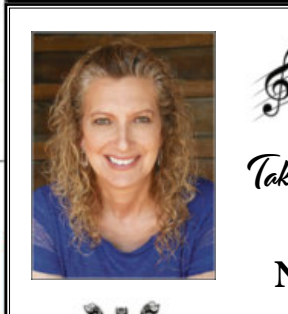
