Words from Our Shepherd

From our Pastor, Rev. Timothy Do

Why should we kneel after the Lamb of God?

Perhaps you have noticed that right after we sing the “Lamb of God”, the priest is now asking parishioners to kneel while he lifts the Eucharistic host and say to the people, “Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.”

And then together with the priest, the people respond, “Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.”

In recent years at our parish, many parishioners have knelt at this part of the Mass, while most parishioners have stood for this part. After years of National Eucharistic Revival, we had the opportunity to reeducate and reflect on the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, now is a good time to standardize what we do in accordance with church teaching.

The church document that governs the Mass is called “The General Instruction of the Roman Missal”. Paragraph 43 of this document discusses our body postures during Mass since our body is part of our worship. Kneeling is a symbol of adoration, and so the document states that “The faithful kneel after the Agnus Dei (Lamb of God) unless the Diocesan Bishop determines otherwise.” (par. 43)

The Bishop of San Bernardino, Bishop Alberto Rojas, has not mandated that we stand, and so the default is that the people should kneel at this part of the Mass. This change also leaves us kneeling in worship as we wait for our turn to come forward to receive the Eucharist. This is typical practice at most Catholic parishes all over the world.

Why does this matter? We believe the liturgy we celebrate here on earth is a participation in the heavenly liturgy. The last book of the Bible – the Book of Revelation – describes the worship in heaven. When the Lamb of God (Jesus) is presented before the throne of heaven, everyone falls down in worship before him (Rev 5:1-14). As we kneel, we acknowledge that Jesus is truly present in the Holy Eucharist, and we kneel down in worship before Him because Jesus is the King of kings and Lord of lords.

Palabras de nuestro Pastor

¿Por qué debemos arrodillarnos después del Cordero de Dios?

Tal vez hayas notado que justo después de cantar el “Cordero de Dios”, el sacerdote ahora invita a los fieles a arrodillarse mientras él levanta la hostia eucarística y dice a la asamblea: “Este es el Cordero de Dios, este es el que quita el pecado del mundo. Dichosos los llamados a la cena del Señor.”

Y luego, junto con el sacerdote, el pueblo responde: “Señor, no soy digno de que entres en mi casa, pero una palabra tuya bastará para sanarme.”

En los últimos años, en nuestra parroquia, muchos feligreses se han arrodillado en esta parte de la Misa, mientras que la mayoría de los feligreses han permanecido de pie durante este momento. Después de años de Renovación Eucarística Nacional, tuvimos la oportunidad de reeducarnos y reflexionar sobre la presencia real de Jesús en la Eucaristía. Ahora es un buen momento para estandarizar lo que hacemos de acuerdo con la enseñanza de la Iglesia.

El documento que regula la Misa se llama "Instrucción General del Misal Romano". El párrafo 43 de este documento trata sobre las posturas del cuerpo durante la Misa, ya que nuestro cuerpo es parte de nuestra adoración. El arrodillarse es un símbolo de adoración, y el documento establece que "Los fieles se arrodillan después del Agnus Dei (Cordero de Dios), a menos que el obispo diocesano disponga lo contrario" (párrafo 43).

El Obispo de San Bernardino, Monseñor Alberto Rojas, no ha ordenado que nos mantengamos de pie, por lo que la norma es que el pueblo se arrodille en esta parte de la Misa. Este cambio también nos deja arrodillados en adoración mientras esperamos nuestro turno para acercarnos a recibir la Eucaristía. Esta es una práctica común en la mayoría de las parroquias católicas en todo el mundo.

¿Por qué es importante esto? Creemos que la liturgia que celebramos aquí en la Tierra es una participación en la liturgia celestial. El último libro de la Biblia – el Libro del Apocalipsis – describe la adoración en el cielo. Cuando el Cordero de Dios (Jesús) es presentado ante el trono celestial, todos se postran en adoración ante Él (Apoc 5:1-14). Al arrodillarnos, reconocemos que Jesús está verdaderamente presente en la Santa Eucaristía, y nos arrodillamos en adoración ante Él porque Jesús es el Rey de reyes y Señor de señores.

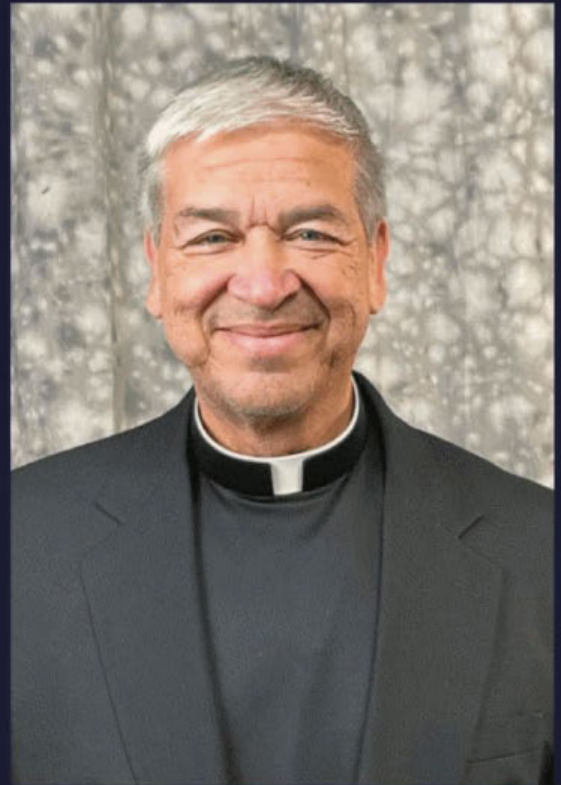
Parish Advent Mission

Pilgrimage of Hope

Pope Francis has declared a Jubilee year for the Church. This has been a tradition of the Church since 1600 that takes place every 25 years. Each Jubilee has a spiritual theme. The theme for the 2025 Jubilee year is "Pilgrims of Hope". The Jubilee year will begin on 24 December, 2024 for the universal Church and begin in all the dioceses of the world on 29 December, 2024. The Jubilee year will conclude on 6 January 2026.

Fr. Rafael Partida, Episcopal Vicar and Director of the Office of Divine Worship, will be providing for the parish spiritual reflections on this Jubilee theme. The parish mission will be on 2 and 3 December in the evenings. On the Monday night he will speak on the Church's understanding of pilgrimage: a journey from where one finds his/herself in life and spiritually journeys to the depth of one's own heart. On the Tuesday night he will speak on the Church's understanding of hope: motivation for humility and for magnanimity; that in God, anything that seems to be lost can be found again.

These reflections may help each of us to prepare for the Holy Year; making ourselves into pilgrims of hope. In a world full of despair and darkness, the message of 'Hope' can offer us a path to peace and help us find light in Christ.

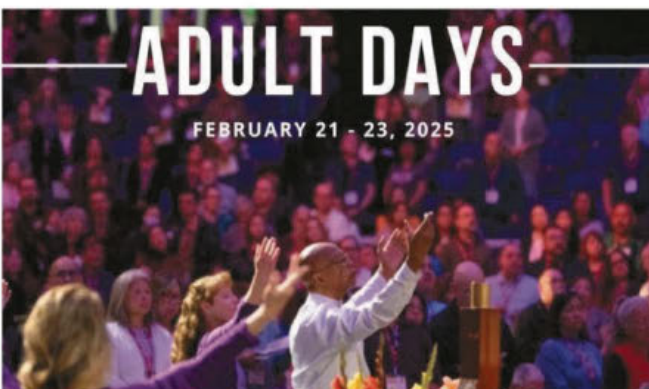

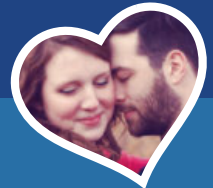
